

Guidelines for preparing Poster flash talk presentations

1. The poster flash talk presentation session is scheduled on 3 December 2019 (Tuesday) from 3.30pm to 4.15pm. Kindly check the programme to reconfirm the timing.
2. The purpose of the flash talk is to stimulate the audience to view the poster and to discuss the research with the author during the presentation session in the exhibition area, where the poster is displayed for the full conference.
3. Poster flash talk presenters are required to prepare a poster in A1 size, free format. The poster will be displayed in a designated exhibition area according to the ID acquired during registration.
4. In addition to that, poster flash talk presenters are required to prepare a slide presentation in Power-Point format (.ppt) using Microsoft PowerPoint in Windows compatible format. Please be noted that there will not be any MAC equipment available.
5. Presenters should prepare a Power-Point presentation not more than 3 slides. The slide should focus only on the main aim of the research, methodology and the key findings. More detailed information can be provided orally during the poster flash talk session.
6. The duration for the presentation is 2 minutes and another 2 minutes for Q&A session by the poster judges and/or other interested audiences.
7. Do not spend time to acknowledge all co-workers, institutes etc. This information is shown on your poster. Focus on your message and research findings.
8. There is a total of 9 flash talk presenters. All presenters are advised to present to the exhibition area 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the session wherein your flash talk is scheduled and wait patiently for your turn.
9. Bring your presentation on a USB flash drive to upload it on the computer before the session starts. The scientific committee will be there to assist you.
